
DEDICATION TO WILLIAM JOHN LAMBERTON. FOUNDING EDITOR

On the occasion of the tenth anniversary of its publication. It was presented at the organizational meeting of the Oklahoma Sociology Association and was immediately adopted as the OSA official journal.
