## XXXIII. OKLAHOMA'S RANK AMONG THE STATES IN NEW WEALTH PER YEAR

Twenty years ago Oklahoma ranked 35th among the states in the value of minerals, with an annual income of $\$ 4,000,000$. Today she ranks second with $\$ 410,000,000$, an increase during the two decades of ten thousand two hundred and fifty per cent.

Oklahoma not only ranks second in the value of minerals but she is now sifth in value of agricultural products. In the total value of both crops and minerals, that is to say in total new wealth per year, she ranks third. Only Texas with 75 years history and nearly four times her area, and Pennsylvania on the Atlantic seaboard with her vast stores of coal excel Oklahomra in annual amount of new wealth. In twenty years Oklahoma has passed the other states until she has attained her present higin rank. And she can retain this rank if she keeps up the pace she has already set, not otherwise.

If Oklahoma will adopt a policy looking toward the development of her dormant natural resources, such as asphalt, salt, gypsum, lead, zinc, stone and clay, all of which she has in abundance, and will see to it that these products are manufactured and used at home, and at the same time conserve her soil she will prosper. If she does not adopt such a policy she will fall from her high estate.

The following table, taken from the latest available statistics, shows the relative rank of the 10 leading states, those whose combined agricultural and mineral wealth exceeds 400,000 ,000 dollars annually.
