

THE BIRDS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA AND VICINITY

EDITH R. FORCE, TULSA

THE purpose of this account is to collect under one head all known information of the manner of occurrence, general locality distribution, record of collections of specimens, as well as that of nests and eggs of breeding species of birds of this area.

The region considered is that of Tulsa County and the adjacent corners of Creek, Rogers and Osage Counties, approximating a radius of thirty-five miles from the City of Tulsa.

Specimens, which are indicated by an asterisk, have been collected of 156 species and subspecies of the 249 birds herein listed. Of the total number recorded, 41 are residents and 58 summer residents and visitors; 23 are winter residents and visitors; 106 are migrants and 21 are of occasional appearance or extinct. Some of the summer and winter residents might be classified as transients, as well. Representative collections of nests and eggs have been made of the 103 species and subspecies which are herein indicated by a dagger (†). The complete list of birds recorded, together with their status, as now known, follows.

In the complete account, specific acknowledgments have been made throughout. The "Sources of Information" includes the list of observers and a bibliography. However, especial thanks and appreciation are expressed to Mr. George W. Morse and Mrs. A. E. Gilmore for records of the breeding birds; to Mr. W. H. Koons, for collections and manuscripts covering observations of five successive years; to Hugh Davis, Jr., for photographic aid; to Isabelle Borders for stenographic assistance; to Dr. H. C. Oberholser, of the U. S. Biological Survey, for the identification of specimens; most of all, to Mrs. Margaret M. Nice, who furnished supplementary material, letters, original manuscripts, as well as the critical consideration of the entire account.

The nomenclature is that of Oberholser, in the identification of the subspecies, and the 1910 American Ornithologists' Union Check-List and its supplements.

A bound copy of the entire manuscript, together with other supplementary material, original data and photographs of specimens and nests recorded, may be found in the Teachers' Library, Board of Education, Tulsa, Oklahoma.
