

TWO LAMPREYS FROM OKLAHOMA

(Abstract)

This paper is a report on the collection of two lampreys from Oklahoma. A specimen of *Ichthyomyzon concolor* was collected by Mr. Burlin Bennett in Spavinaw Lake March 19, 1932. This specimen has nine cusps on the infraroral lamina, three cusps on the supraoral lamina, and fifty-one muscular impressions. It measures 151 mm.

In April, 1931, Mr. Jack Baker collected a specimen of *Reighardina-unicolor* from Barren Fork Creek ten miles east of Tahlequah, Oklahoma. This specimen measures 161 mm. in length, and has three cusps at the supraoral lamina.

These specimens have been placed in the Oklahoma A. and M. College collection.
