
A CHECK LIST OF THE LAND SNAILS OF OKLAHOMA

The following list has been compiled from *Land Mollusca of North America* by Henry A. Pilsbry and from the records of the U. S. National Museum. The localities listed in the former source are designated by "P" and those from the latter by "N". County records are given wherever possible, while less specific locality records are included in quotation marks. Nearly two-thirds of Oklahoma's 77 counties are unrepresented in the two largest shell collections in the United States. Here is a wide-open field for amateur collectors.
