

## Oklahoma Gastropods: Range Extensions, A Faunal Addition, and a Nomenclatural Change\*

During the past year, collections of snails from 18 Oklahoma counties have yielded 107 new county records and one new state record. These records represent data for 57 species, and supplement the work of Branson and Wallen (1), Dundee (2), Lutz (5), Wallen (6), Wallen and Dunlap (7), and Webb (8).

Wallen and Dunlap (7) recorded *Viviparus lecythoides* Benson for Oklahoma in 1963, a name that is regarded as synonymous with *V. malleatus* Reeve. Hannibal (3) first adopted the former for this species in 1908, but in 1911 (4) indicated that the name was probably a synonym of *V. malleatus*.

*Bulimulus alternatus mariae* (Albers) 1850 is reported herein for the first time in Oklahoma. This species is readily distinguished from its near relative, *B. dealbatus*, by its thicker shell, more distinct mottling, and dark aperture. As this form is usually found quite some distance below the Red River, this record may represent a mechanical introduction, probably by a tourist. However, since the snails were still living when found, it is quite possible that the species could be successful in Oklahoma.
