(1903-1957)

Miss Fulhage was born at Yates Center, Kansas, August 13, 1903 and died August 11, 1957 in Oklahoma City, after a long illness.

She received her B. S. degree from Kansas State College, did graduate work at Iowa State College and took the M. S. degree from Kansas State Teacher's College, Pittsburg. At the time of her death, she was a doctoral student at the University of Oklahoma.

Miss Fulhage, an associate professor of biology, had served the Oklahoma Baptist University for the past ten years. She was a member of the Baptist Church, American Association of University Women, Business and Professional Women's Club, Oklahoma Academy of Science, Southwestern Association of Naturalists, Beta Beta Beta and Eastern Star.
