Additions to the Oklahoma Lichen Flora — No. 2¹

All species listed are thought to represent additions to the Oklahoma lichen flora. Specimens are deposited in the lichen collection at the Oklahoma University Biological Station, with duplicates of each in my private collection.

Porina nucula Ach. var. *heterospora* Fink, on holly, by Little River 6 miles north of Idabel, McCurtain Co., 1816.

Calicium subtile Pers., on old post oak, by Happy Hollow, Marshall Co., 1798.

Arthothelium spectabile (Flot.) Mass., on post oak, by Blue River near Connerville, Johnston Co., 1802.

Opegrapha viridis Pers., on red oak, at Beaver's Bend State Park, McCurtain Co., 1204B.

Phaeographis dendritica (Ach.) Müll. Arg., on red oak, at Beaver's Bend State Park, McCurtain Co., 1204C.

Graphina sophisticascens (Nyl.) Zahlbr., on birch, 8 miles southeast of Bennington, Bryan Co., 1444.

Ochrolechia pallescens (L.) Mass., on hickory, at Beaver's Bend State Park, McCurtain Co., 1179.

Parmelia livida Tayl., on hickory, in Sulphur Canyon 15 miles southeast of Clayton, Pushmataha Co., 1699.

Parmelia quercina (Willd.) Vain., on holly, by Little River 6 miles north of Idabel, McCurtain Co., 1817.

Buellia fimbriata (Tuck.) Imshaug, on limestone, 10 miles south of Sulphur by Highway 18, Carter Co., 1759.
