## **Elbert Frank Allen**

## 1890-1963

Elbert Frank Allen was born January 21, 1890, at Cloverdale, Indiana. He died November 20, 1963, at Stillwater, Oklahoma.

The Bachelor of Arts degree was granted to Elbert Frank Allen by Indiana State Teachers' College in 1915. He taught three years in Indiana Public Schools and one year in the University of Chicago High School.

He received the degree of Doctor of Philosophy at the University of Missouri in 1923. He was made Professor of Mathematics in the University of Missouri in 1924 and taught there four years.

In 1928 he was made Head of Mathematics and Physics in Kentucky State College in Morehead.

In 1929 he became Professor of Mathematics in Oklahoma State University. After retirement from Oklahoma State University in 1956 Dr. Allen was a Visiting Professor of Mathematics at the University of Houston.

Dr. Allen was a member of the Oklahoma Academy of Science, the Mathematical Association of America, the Society of Sigma Xi and Pi Mu Epsilon. Dr. Allen organized and sponsored the Pi Mu Epsilon chapter at Oklahoma State University. —Harriet G. Barclay.
