Charles Mathias Goethe

1875-1966

Charles Mathias Goethe was born in Sacramento, California, 28 March 1875. He died 10 July 1966.

C. M. Goethe was a banker by profession. During an active business career he headed various companies and owned several California ranches. He was a patron of the arts as well as a vigorous supporter of the biological sciences. He was especially interested in the betterment of man through eugenics and euthenics. The great list of societies of which he was a member attests to his broad interests in his fellow men.

During the past decade or so Mr. Goethe made money available to the Oklahoma Academy of Science for memberships in the Academy for needy married graduate students and for many Academy meeting "coffee breaks." —C. A. Levengood.
