

Notes on Oklahoma Plants

The following two species are reported as new to Oklahoma. The specimens are deposited in the Herbarium of the University of Oklahoma.

Pea autumnalis Muhl. McCurtain Co.: dam at city lake, Broken Bow, 27 April 1957, Carl D. Riggs. This species of bluegrass has been collected from as nearby as Arkansas and eastern Texas.

Cayaponia grandifolia (T. & G.) Small. McCurtain Co.: forest floodplain along Little River, six miles south of Broken Bow, 18 July 1964, Robert Pearce 1441. This member of the gourd family is a plant of the southeastern United States.
