**A New Treehopper (Homoptera: Membracidae)  
Record for Oklahoma**

A male specimen of *Telamona concava* Fitch, collected 11 May 1964 in Latimer County, Oklahoma, was recently found in my collections. No host is indicated. Apparently, it escaped notice when I prepared my paper (Dennis, 1965) on Oklahoma treehoppers. Since it has not been previously reported from the state this is a new record.

This is an easily recognized telamon because it is the only local species with a definite, but variable, brown and green color pattern on the pronotum. The posterior margin of the crest is often slightly sinuate.
