

DISTRIBUTION OF OKLAHOMA GRASSLAND SPIDERS AND NEW RECORDS FOR THE STATE¹

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Data for 18 families, 53 genera, and 81 species are reported; 7 genera and 17 species are added to the list known from Oklahoma.

At the time of her death (February, 1968), Dr. Harriet Exline Frizzell was verifying the senior author's diagnoses of a relatively large series of spiders, secured primarily by Drew and his students from most of the counties of Oklahoma. In her last communication, Dr. Frizzell indicated that she had completed most of the work, and she included a list of verifications. These spiders form the basis for this report. We are also indebted to Drs. W. Ivie and W. J. Gertsch for identifying some specimens. Several specimens were retained by Dr. Frizzell and, hence, are in her collection at Central Missouri State College, under the care of Dr. William B. Peck. The remainder are in reposition at Oklahoma State University.

No single check-list for Oklahoma is available. Excluding various monographic presentations, reference to which may be found in the papers herein cited, only eight works bear directly on the Oklahoma spider fauna (1-8). A total of 281 species were listed in the eight papers.

This paper presents data for 18 families, 53 genera, and 81 species, seven genera and 17 species of which were heretofore unrecorded for Oklahoma. In the annotated list, new records for the state are marked by an asterisk, and all forms are referred to the proper collecting sites by number; the figures in italics indicate the number of specimens collected.

ANNOTATED LIST

Ctenizidae

Ummidia species. 1, 1♀.

Amaurobiidae

Dictynidae

Dictyna bellens Chamberlin. 25, 1; 54, 1; 55, 2; 56, 1; 57, 1. All immature or females. Previously reported from Oklahoma as *D. longispina* Barrows.

Dictyna coloradensis Chamberlin. 3, 1♂; 58, 1. Primarily an eastern, northern, and western species.

Loxosceles reclusa Gertsch and Mulaik, 3, 2♀; 55, 2♀.

All specimens of this venomous species were secured from residence halls. Doctor C. W. Wingo and his associates at the University of Missouri have essentially proven the necroticity of *L. reclusa* to human tissues (10).

Salticidae
