OCCURRENCE OF THE CRAYFISH CAMBARELLUS PUER HOBBS (DECAPODA: CAMBARIDAE) IN SOUTHEASTERN OKLAHOMA

One adult female Cambarellus puer was collected from a swamp on Little River, 7 mi. south of Broken Bow, McCurtain County, Oklahoma (March 24, 1974). This is the first specimen of this species and the first species of this genus reported from Oklahoma. Reimer (1) reports this species from the Little River drainage in Little River County, Arkansas, and the authors have one female from 1 mi. east of the Oklahoma-Arkansas state line, Sevier County, Arkansas (collected April 29, 1973).
