NEW FOSSIL CRINOIDS FROM LEGRAND, IOWA

(Abstract)

Since the publication of Crinoidea Camerata by Wachsmuth and Springer in 1897, a tremendous number of excellently preserved fossil crinoids have been collected from the famous LeGrand quarries. In the light of the large number of additional specimens available for study, a complete revision of the fauna was undertaken in 1932. Recent quarrying operations during the summers of 1935 and 1936 have fortunately exposed additional colonies of crinoids among which several new species have been discovered.
