OKLAHOMA BIRD RECORDS COMMITTEE: 2001 REPORT

This is the annual report of the Oklahoma Bird Records Committee (hereafter OBRC) of the Oklahoma Ornithological Society. The OBRC requests and reviews documentations of rare and unusual records as per the Date Guide to the Occurrences of Birds in Oklahoma (Third Ed., 2000, Oklahoma Ornithological Society, Tulsa; hereafter the Date Guide). The OBRC publishes full, quarterly seasonal reports in The Scissortail, the newsletter of the Oklahoma Ornithological Society. This report summarizes the activities of the OBRC for the calendar year 2001, including any decisions pending from prior years. OBRC members evaluating 2001 records included in this report were: Jim Arterburn, Bill Carter, Jeff Cox, Bonnie Gall, Joe Grzybowski, Jo Loyd, Larry Mays, Dan Reinking, Jim Thayer, and Don Verser.

During 2001, the OBRC received 695 records from 42 observers: 630 records of 170 species were accepted (91%), 43 records of 37 species were rejected (6%), and 22 records of 19 species required no action by the Committee (3%). Below are comments on 95 records for species that were either first state records, or for those species that have no dates listed in the Date Guide: 85 of those records were accepted (89%) and 10 records were rejected (11%).

Two species, Cave Swallow (Petrochelidon fulva) and Grace's Warbler (Dendrocia graciae), were added to the Oklahoma state list in hypothetical status in 2001. This brings the number of species on The Oklahoma Ornithological Society Check-List of Oklahoma Birds to 458, of which 17 are in hypothetical status (based on written documentation alone, or for species where wild origin was uncertain).

The records in this report are arranged taxonomically following the AOU Check-list of North American Birds, Seventh Edition (AOU 1998) through the 43rd supplement published in 2002 (Auk 119: 897-906). Each record consists of the English name, scientific name, OBRC record number(s), number of individuals and age and sex if known, specific location and county of observation (county in italics), date(s) of observation, observer(s) [if the record was accepted], and any comments. All observers who submitted documentation (written descriptions or photographs) of accepted records are listed. The observer who first discovered the bird and/or submitted the documentation is in italics. For rejected records, the observer's name is omitted and an explanation is given detailing the reason(s) for rejection.

- Violet-green Swallow (Tachycineta thalassina), (2001-523). One individual at Boise City Sewage Ponds, Cimarron, on 6 September 2001. Joseph A Grzybowski.
- Cave Swallow (Petrochelidon fulva), (2001-595). One adult and 3 juveniles at Hackberry Flat, Tillman, on 19 July 2001. Joseph A. Grzybowski. First state record.. Added to state list in hypothetical status because record based only on written documentation.
- Black-capped Ćhickadee (Poecile atricapillus), (2001-045). One adult at Black Mesa State Park, Cimarron, on 13 December 2000. Joseph A. Grzybowski.
- Townsend's Warbler (Dendrocia townsendi), (2111-550). One adult photographed at Black Mesa State Park, Cimarron, on 24 April 2001. David Wiggins.
- Townsend's Warbler (Dendrocia townsendi), (2001-522). One individual at Regnier Ranch, Cimarron, on 6 September 2001. Joseph A. Grzybowski.
- Pyrrhuloxia (Cardinalis sinuatus), (2001-625). One adult female photographed at Wichita Mountains NWR, Comanche, on 12 December 2001 and observed through 21 February 2002. Kurt Meisenzahl.

RECORDS REJECTED

The OBRC believes that it is important to note that rejection of a record does not necessarily mean the identification was incorrect. In some cases the conditions of the observation were brief or distant, or the observation was made under difficult viewing conditions. In other cases the description provided was incomplete or did not rule out other possible species. The OBRC thanks all contributors of documentations and strongly encourages continued participation in this process, which serves to strengthen the ornithological record of bird occurrences in Oklahoma.

- Mottled Duck (Anas fulvigula), (2001-500-542-560). One adult male at Red Slough WMA, McCurtain, from 23 August 2001 through 23 September 2001. Description was brief and did not rule out American Black Duck (Anas rubripes).
- Black Scoter (Melanitta nigra), (2001-667). One immature at Lake Yahola, Tulsa, on 18 November 2001. Brief description did not rule out other scoters or Ruddy Duck (Oxyura jamaicensis).
- Barrow's Coldeneye (Bucephala clangula), (2001-085). One adult male below Keystone Dam, Tulsa, on 17 December 2000. Bird could not be identified due to small image of bird in the photograph, position of the bird in the photograph, and position of the bird relative to the sun.
- Swallow-tailed Kite (Elanoides forficatus), (2001-314). Two adults near Mt. Scott in Wichita Mountains NWR, Comanche, on 12 June 2001. Written description incorrect on 1 point of identification for Swallow-tailed Kite; description did not rule out Mississippi Kite (Icitnia mississippiensis).
- Mew Gull (Larus canus), (2001-314). One adult at Lake Hefner, Oklahoma, on 30 January 2001. If accepted, this record would have constituted a first state record. However, the OBRC believed that Ring-billed Gull (Larus delawarensis) was not ruled out by the description.
- Clark's Nutcracker (Nucifraga columbiana), (2001-315). One adult near Highway 44 bridge over North Fork of Red River, Greer, on 5 June 2001. Description did not eliminate other species.
- Golden-winged Warbler (Vermivora chrysoptera), (2001-673). One adult male at Oxley Nature Center, Tulsa, on 9 September 2001. While the description did point to Golden-winged Warbler, it was very incomplete, lacking details of supportive characteristics that could qualify the reliability of noted characteristics.
- Cape May Warbler (Dendroica tigrina), (2001-329). One bird at Lake Oologah, Rogers, on 5 May 2001. The brief view and description of this bird were inadequate for acceptance.
